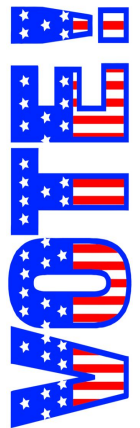
## Get Involved - Help Your Child & Our School

## Frequently Asked Question (FAQ): Why 'NWEA Tests'?

MA utilizes NWEA MAPS assessments as a district benchmark.

We assess students within 10 days of the first enrollment, and then 2-3 more times throughout the year to measure growth over time.

- **Students test at home in Reading and Math.** The test is computer-adaptive (it changes depending on the response).
- **Results (RIT & score reports) are e-mailed home,** and help teachers make specific and individualized learning goals for students in core classes.
- **We CELEBRATE** as students' skills and knowledge INCREASE over time as evidenced by an increase in RIT scores.
